Hilltop Community Suppers is hosted by First Congregational Church (FCC) of West Dundee as an outreach effort for the Northern Fox Valley area. The Community Suppers provide a delicious, healthy, monthly meal that is served restaurant sit-down style to members of our community in a friendly environment. These meals are free to anyone who wants them, though voluntary donations are accepted.

The concept of the community suppers has had a long and successful history amongst a group of churches in the St. Charles, Geneva, and Batavia area. They offer these meals in their community seven different times a month. Community suppers are different than a soup kitchen in that these dinners strive to build a diverse dining experience by providing an opportunity to share a supper with other community members. ## Volunteers Serving Meals

**Thank you so much for volunteering to serve meals at The Hilltop Community Supper Outreach Program. Your service is an invaluable tool in helping make this program a success.**

1. Please sign in, fill out a name tag for yourself and put on an apron.
2. Make sure your hair is tied back and away from your face.
3. Wash your hands right before serving time.
4. Review the menu and become familiar with the different stations.
5. Be ready at your assigned table when the guests arrive.
6. Please smile and greet your guests and help them to feel comfortable and welcome. Topic of conversation to get the dialog started might include: the weather, how they heard about the dinner, the delicious menu being served that evening....
7. Make eye contact and review the menu with the guests.
8. Fill out an order ticket for each person.
9. Bring the requested drinks and salads to each of your guests as soon as possible. Serve the ladies and oldest guests first.
10. When salads are about half finished, place the order at the window.
11. Watch for your table number to be posted for pick up.
12. Serve your guests from the left side.
13. Keep an eye on your guests and make sure they are happy with their dinner. Always be on the lookout if your guests need anything. Make sure everyone's needs are being attended to.
14. Ask, when they are done, if you may clear their plates and glasses.
15. As your guests get up to leave, thank them once again for coming and state that you hope they will be able to join us next month for a meal. Your positive attitude and welcoming personality will make our dinners a success.
16. Help clear the table and replenish water, if necessary, for the next round of guests.
17. When your shift is over, please check with the coordinator to make sure it is a good time for you to sit down and enjoy a **free-well deserved meal!**

RELEASE AND LIABILITY WAIVER

This Release and Waiver must be signed prior to participating in the Hilltop Community Suppers.

I, the undersigned, desire to work as a volunteer or to have a minor child work as a volunteer in activities related to the Hilltop Community Suppers held by the First Congregational Church of Dundee. I hereby freely, voluntarily and without duress execute this Release:

1. Waiver and Release. I hereby release, discharge and hold harmless the First Congregational Church of Dundee, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, members or agents, and their successors and assigns (collectively "FCC") from any and all liability, claims and demands of any kind or nature that arise or may hereafter arise from the Participant's activities with the Hilltop Community Suppers. I understand that this Release discharges FCC from any liability or claim that I and my minor child if the Participant is a child may have against FCC for any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death or property damage that may result from the Participant's activities with the Hilltop Community Suppers, whether caused by the negligence of FCC or otherwise, and waives all claims against FCC for any injuries, loss or damages I and my minor child if the Participant is a minor child may sustain.
2. Assumption of the Risk. I understand that the Participant's activities for the Hilltop Community Suppers include work that may be hazardous to the Participant. I and my child if the Participant is a minor child hereby expressly and specifically assume the risk of injury or harm in these activities.
3. Other. This Release shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit off the parties and their heirs, successors, assigns and personal representatives.
